

Graduation Policies for San Manuel Stadium

Congratulations on your graduation! We aim to provide a safe, clean, and fun environment for your event. San Manuel stadium will continue to adhere to all safety measures set forth by State and County health guidelines. Please find below general guidelines while visiting the stadium and policies specific to commencement ceremonies at San Manuel Stadium.

BAG POLICY

In an effort to enhance public safety, San Manuel Stadium prohibits all bags, backpacks, and other carriers from being brought into the stadium with the following exceptions (in each case, after proper inspection):

- Purses or bags that are 4.5" x 6.5" with a single zipper closure/flap (approximately the size of an adult hand) or smaller
- Medically necessary items, including diaper bags
- Guests are permitted to bring in one clear one (1) gallon bag per person
- Other than the above-noted exceptions, all other bags must be returned to the attendee's vehicle.

CONTAINER POLICY

No outside food or beverages of any kind may be brought into the Stadium. No coolers of any kind are allowed, and all bags, backpacks and purses will be subject to search by stadium staff. One (1) Sealed 20 oz. bottle or less of water may be allowed in the gates per person.

GRADUATION DECORATIONS

To avoid disruptions in the ceremony, the following items below are not allowed in the stadium. The list is not exhaustive and San Manuel Stadium staff have the authority to make a judgment call on what is allowed in the stadium.

- No balloons
- No signs
- No noise makers

VENDORS

For public safety, no unapproved vendors are allowed on the property. All unapproved vendors will be asked to leave by security.

FIRST AID

First aid room is in the main concourse near the main entrance. If you need First Aid, please contact the nearest employee for help. Ingestible medication is not available.



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ANIMALS

No animals are allowed in the stadium besides service animals specifically trained to aid a person with a disability.

FACE MASK POLICY

All guests are required to always wear face coverings or masks in the stadium except when seated and actively eating or drinking. Masks must completely cover the wearer's nose and mouth. This requirement does not apply to children under the age of two (2).

PHYSICAL & SOCIAL DISTANCE

Social distance guidelines will be enforced throughout San Manuel Stadium. Signage, floor markers and other resources will remind guests to remain physically distanced.
